INTRODUCTION

RETHINK SUSTAINABILITY: the impact of our actions

is a hands-on international youth exchange connected to sustainability, climate change and artistic expressions. The aim of the project is to empower young people to become active social change-makers by acquiring new skills, knowledge and environmental understanding.

The "Rethink sustainability: the impact of our actions" project is an 8 day youth exchange that brings together 25 young people from Italy, Spain, Portugal, Poland and Ireland to share their view on sustainable living, understanding the impact of the everyday actions, participate in artistic workshops and DIY eco workshops.





Throughout the week we will explore how are everyday actions impact others and the environment, explore sustainable alternatives to products and habits, talk about the impact of climate change on human rights and use artistic forms of expression to raise awareness on global challenges.

TVESDAY 03/06

This day is all about arrivals, discovering the space and surroundings of our youth exchange location and getting a good rest after a long day of travelling

WEDNESDAY 04/06

The next day is dedicated to getting to know each other, talk about the program and do parallel upcycling workshops while talking about fast fashion.

THVrsDAY 05/06

Thursday is dedicated to sustainability when it comes to food and daily self care, visiting an urban garden where we will learn about edible plants and how plants can be used in diy bodycare products.

FriDAY 06/06

The next day is dedicated to reflecting on the impact of climate change on humans rights and talk about challenges in our countries and communities. Through serigraphy workshops and artistic sessions, we will create powerful messages to raise awareness.

SATURDAY 07/06

Saturday we explore the city through urban trekking paths, talking about sustainable and livable architecture as well as innovative designs for the future.

SVNDAY 08/06


On Sunday we go for a hike in the mountains and reflect on alpine biodiversity, as well as artistic expressions through natural elements.

TRENTO, ITALY

We will meet in Trento, a beautiful town with a population of about 120,000 inhabitants. Trento is situated in the north of Italy, near the border with Austria, and is known for its beautiful countryside, with lovely mountains and lakes. It is an excellent opportunity for hiking, sailing, and mountain bikes trips.



ACCOMMODATION

The house is located in Candriai, a mountain area nearby Trento. The house is a self-management house with a nice equipped kitchen, a common room and shared bedrooms for 3-4 people. There will be wi-fi, a projector for music and movie nights and a wide outdoor space for activities.



The exchange will be organized as "self management". We will be divided in groups and we will prepare delicious meals and international dinners. We will also eat out in some of the days:)


ELIGIBLE TRANSPORTATION
