We also took part in the "on-arrival training" for many EVS volunteers in Sommières. We spend 5 days, taking about our expectations, plans, fears and possible problems. I had a really nice time and I met many cool people.

In the beginning of October, we met French volunteers, who were also part of the Unis-Cité team for this year. All in all, we were 48 volunteers in Lyon (45 French and 3 international). In Unis-Cité all volunteers are working in groups. They have one long-term project and two or three short-term projects. The groups for a long-term project and for a short-term projects are

Our first short term project was in EHPAD. We were making animations for old people, for example we were playing games with them, drawing, painting, playing cards, organizing the spectacle for Christmas etc... Our second short-term project was in the association La Miete (Maison de l'Initiative, de l'Engagement, du Troc et de l'Échange) where we were supposed to organize some events in an idea of "exchange of the services without money".

My first choice was an environmental project. I was integrated in a team of 3 French volunteers and the main goal of our project was to teach and instruct people how to save energy and water in their homes. We were making animation and workshops in the "pedagogical apartment" in Venissieux. We were also organizing games for children, from the local social centre.
