Some words about Trento.

Trento is the capital city of the autonomous province of Trentino Alto-Adige, situated in the Adige river valley in North Italy. The city has a population 120.000 of around inhabitants excluding the periphery layouts and is a educational, scientific major and political centre with sheltering the University of Trento which is ranked among the best universities in Italy and in Europe. Having the advantage of being a university city, Trento enjoys a number of student oriented cultural activities also at an international level.

Trento is well-connected to the neighboring cities through railway, among others:

Verona in about one hour, Bolzano in 40minutes and Vicenza in 1,5hours.



Within easy commute are also located Lake Caldonazzo and the famous Lake Garda, which can be reached in about 1,5hours from Trento. The city has a picturesque Medieval and Renaissance historic centre, with typical ancient buildings and touristic attraction points such as the Trento Cathedral and the Castello del Buonconsiglio.

Keep in mind that there are many students in Trento, but they are here to study and there is no nightlife, no discos and most bars close at midnight :-)



InCo is a non-profit organization which has the mission of promoting the international exchange between young people, to increase and improve the level of contact among different cultures, stimulating intercultural sensibility and preventing and combating racism, prejudices and social exclusion.

The organization was created in 2004 by a group of enthusiastic former volunteers who decided to assist other peers in furthering their intercultural abilities and non-formal education. The organization kept on growing, and at the moment it counts on a staff of five people, all with wide international experiences.

The activities of the association are currently addressing mainly young people, but there are also opportunities even for people over 30 to join new exchanges programme. Since 2011 an independent volunteering exchange scheme was set up to allow the participation in international volunteering for people aged over 30.

The main activities of the organization are the following:

- European Solidaity Corps (ESC) since 2004 as an accredited sending and coordinating organization since 2006. Since then, InCo coordinated hosting projects for over 250 youngsters, and sent about 200 Italians abroad. Since 2013 InCo is also a hosting organization.From 2015, InCo is part of the Rete Italiana Volontariato Europeo (RIVE: Italian Network European Volunteering).
- Youth exchanges: InCo started organizing youth exchanges in 2015; since then we organize at least 3-4 youth exchanges in Trento every year (where our volunteers help us) and has taken part in different youth exchanges all over Europe.
- ▶ Promotion of international volunteering activities: with personal informative meetings (info-day in Trento and other parts of the province), different means of communication, such as website, local and national newsletters, social networks and flyers distributed in libraries, community centres' etc. InCo has also created the platform SCOPRIAMO IL MONDO in collaboration with several organizations of Trentino dealing with international mobility as well as with international cooperation where young people can find information about most of the opportunities to make an experience abroad offered by associations seated in Trentino.



The volunteers' tasks could be summarized:

Office activities (communication and administration):

Preparation of documents and materials (letters, newsletters, brochures, flyers, guidelines, spreadsheets, emails) especially in the framework of ESC and Youth Exchanges.

Prepare presentations, infopacks, questionaries, charts etc

Translation of news, writing articles for web and development of Social network(Facebook/Instagram/Inco website). Provide it with appropriate photo, video, graphics and animation; Develop the Blog of current volunteers (www.gogosocial.blogspot.com)

Help the staff in coordinating the parallel activities of ESC

Participate in info-day meetings in schools, conferences, events etc

Participate in meetings of information and orientation desk

Preparation and development of meetings with international volunteers:

- Blog monthly meetings
- On-arrival and midterm trainings
- Monitoring meetings
- Final evaluation meeting

Active participation in Youth exchanges:

- Prepare infopacks, posters, videos, application forms, articles etc for web
- Search for the participants
- Communicate with local and international partners/participants
- Support the staff in preparing practical and logistic matters for the project
- Support the staff during and after the project

Promotion and information activities about international mobility (ESC, MTV, Youth exchanges etc): Info-days, International Mobility Fair, information sessions at schools.



You will get free accommodation for the whole duration of your voluntary service. You will share a private apartment with other volunteers at the following address: Via Zandonai 2, Pergine.

You will receive food allowance for each month, paid by InCo. So you will be able able to cook/prepare breakfasts, lunch and dinners in the apartment.

You will receive 180,00 € per month as pocket money.
