INCO ASSOCIAZIONE

CARITAS DIOCESI BOLZANO-BRESSANONE



"Caritas" is a Latin word which means "love" (charity). Without love, says the apostle Paul, "I am nothing". The message of which Caritas is the bearer: only love (to love and be loved) saves and gives meaning to life. Diocesan Caritas carries out its mandate by trying to identify situations of poverty of persons and groups of people, discovering and enhancing the experiences of solidarity already present in society and in the church, carefully observing cultural changes and social developments, reminding each his own social responsibility: to Christians, to citizens, to the private sector, to associations, to politics.

It does all this mainly by offering services and activating projects of accompaniment, help, sharing and collaboration with people in situations of poverty



THE PROJECT: WHAT WILL YOU DO?



The volunteers will participate in the activities proposed by Caritas Diocesi Bolzano – Bressanone, its partners and other partners working with young people and people at risk of social exclusion. The volunteers will be part of a team and they will participate in staff meetings and in meetings with other volunteers. Volunteers will be mainly involved in the office of the YoungCaritas but they will have the opportunity to collaborate with other services of the Caritas Bolzano. Main activities are the following:

YoungCaritas

Organization and implementation of workshops at schools about social issues and international solidarit. Organization and implementation of special events such as "Corsa dei Miracoli", "Fiera del volontariato", "72 ore senza compromesso" Holidays and recreational activitie. But als, you will collaborate with:

1 - Services for refugees: Casa Aaron, Casa Arnica, Casa Sara, Casa Miriam, Casa del pescatore, Casa Anna, Casa Freinademetz (both for migrants and Italians) and casa Migrantes. Attending trainings for interculturality, migration and integration. Organizing and implementing recreational activities for children. Assisting children in doing their homework. Database maintenance- entry and processing of personal information. Supporting refugees in their language learning path. 2 - Services for homeless person: Casa Arché, Casa Magret, Casa dell'ospitalità implementing and organizing recreational activitie. The community life as for example helping for the preparation of lunch/dinner the guests. 3 - For people with AIDS: Casa Emmaus and Iris Caffè Implementing and organizing recreational activities as well as special event. 4 - Disabled People Implementing and organizing recreational activities as well as special event. 5 - People with addiction problems: Binario 7 Implementing and organizing recreational activities as well as special event. 6 - People with psychic problem: Centro diurno Plan some recreational activitie, bring some new ideas. Help by cooking.

Your activities will take 30-35 hours/week, from Monday to Friday.

Sometimes the volunteer will be requested to take part in activities also during weekend. In any case, volunteers will never collaborate more than 5 consecutive day/week and will always have 2 days off.



The volunteer will be offered accommodation in a shared flat with their own private room. The flat includes shared kitchen, living room and bathroom. All rooms are equipped and Internet is included.



THE CITY: BOLZANO

Bolzano is the capital cityof the province of South Tyrol in northern Italy. With a population of 108,245, Bolzano is also by far the largest city in South Tyrol and Bolzano-Bozen is an autonomous province situated in North Italy with having its borders to Austria and Switzerland. Together with Trento, it makes up the region of Trentino Alto Adige/Südtirol one of the five autonomous regions in Italy. Bolzano happens to be a unique example of cohabitation with hosting Austro-Hungarian origined inhabitants as majority of its population who speak an Austro-Bavarian dialect of German, about a guarter of the province is Italian-speaking and a small minority speaks Ladin as mother tongue, while both Italian and German are the official languages of Bolzano-Bozen. As a result of sheltering a multilingual and multicultural population, Bolzano happens to be one of the most important examples of 'coexistence atmosphere' in the territory of Italy. The province in total has more than 500.000 inhabitants and hosts the Free University of Bozen which makes it easier to find free time activities compared to the rest of the smaller Italian cities. Bolzano is also blessed with the luck of being situated among the Alps and the Dolomites which were declared as world heritage by UNESCO in 2009. The town of Bolzano is in easy commute to Trento, where InCo is :-), in about 40 minutes by train and in about 1,5 hours to Innsbruck, Austria.


INCO'S CONTACT



Bici Bolzano is the "bike-sharing" project promoted by the Municipality of Bolzano as part of an important and broad-based mobility strategy aimed at creating an integrated public transport network able to offer citizens and tourists a range of alternatives for urban transport.

To use this service you have to register at https://bolzan.ecospazio.it/ and pick up your bike at the nearest station.

The cost is € 1,00 per hour for a maximum of 3 hours.
