Some words about Molfetta

The project will take place in Molfetta, a city in Apulia, on the Adriatic coast at about 25 km from Bari. Molfetta has around 60.000 inhabitants. In the last years Molfetta's commercial activities and attractions have been improved, thanks to the recent construction of a huge shopping area, equipped with international stores, national chain stores, outlet with all-year discounts, cinema and so on. At the same time in the historical centre there are many restaurants, cafes, bars and youth meeting point crowed during the week-end especially in the evening.

The climate is generally mild and poor of rain, although the temperature changes are fast and short, due to the wind from the Balkan area. In spite of the fact that our area has good road, railways, air and maritime facilities, and that it has strategic links with the East-Mediterranean and Balkan countries, it is quite distant from the so-called heart of Europe.

During the national/local holidays important roles play in the city traditions and religious happening such as Easter processions and rituals, the traditional Feast in September, the event of live nativity scene in Christmass time.

Camper Club Trullo Beach Molfetta

Camper Club Trullo Beach is a non-profit organization born in 2015 in Molfetta, with the aim to foster environment-friendly relationship between man and nature. The organization is located outside the city, on the seaside between Molfetta and Giovinazzo and provides services and resting area for campers and travelers, who like this kind of experience.

The main goal of Trullo Beach is promotion of sustainable and solidarity tourism, by carrying out recreational and sports initiatives and activities, facilitating cultural exchange between travelers and locals, providing inclusion and adequate assistance to those with fewer opportunities and with disabilities, taking care of our environment and biodiversity.

The main objectives of the organization are to:

- Promote and coordinate different outdoors sports activities, tourist camping, gardening, grilling, etc... With care and special attention to the protection of nature and sea.
- Support children and people with disabilities. The organization offers easy access to the sea and provides opportunities of playing outdoor and learning in a non-formal environment.
- Collaborate with other associations and develop some environmental and social projects.

Proposed activities for volunteers

The volunteers will be involved in everyday activities carried out in the organization and other locations in town based on a particular activity. The volunteers will work generally 36 hours/week from 9 to 13 and in the afternoon also from 16 to 19.

The main activities of the project include:

- Assist the staff members in organizing and preparing the area of the bar, beach, leisure and relax space such as chairs and tables, books, games, grill etc..;
- Organize and carry out activities for children, such as energizers, reading, drawing, playing, sports...;
- Support and assist children or adults with disabilities at the beach or in using services of the organization, coordinating and organizing recreational activities for them;
- Making arts and crafts out of objects and rubbish found on the beach, such as bottles, taps, nets...
- Participating in events and celebrations organized for some national or religious holidays (for example "The night of San Lorenzo", etc...);

- Taking part in cleaning initiatives, either the sea or the nearby area;
- Supporting the staff in everyday activities, by occasionally preparing some typical dishes from volunteer's home country, doing barbecue, gardening, etc...;
- Creating promotional material and digital content such as photos, videos, posters, brochures, blogs... Updating social media channels and web site;
- Organizing language laboratories, language caffe, tandem etc...;
- Organizing a sort of "free walking tours" in Molfetta for foreign travelers.

A very important part play the complementary activities, where all the volunteers take part and are actively involved with their creativity and ideas. They consist in: Christmas Chorus in November-December, literature events (the volunteers read poems in mother tongue), international evenings, dissemination event regarding Europe (Europe day, Holocaust day, International day for the elimination of violence against women, etc...).

Food and accommodation

The volunteers will live in a fully equipped flat/board house together with other volunteers, in the city of Molfetta (double room).

The lodging choice will be always decided by InCo. In any case volunteers will have to respect the rules of the structure and the environment where they live.

There are possibilities for the volunteers to have their meals at home, in the kitchen which is fully furnished. So in this case an additional amount of money will be provided corresponding to 180 euros.
