Summary

According to his skills, abilities and knowledge, the volunteer will develop activities of the various departments of Surf Clube de Viana and will support the activities proposes to develop during 2018. Will be reported directly to the direction, under his guidance and will too collaborate with the monitors in their daily activities. Will also carry out a collaboration with the APPACDM Association.

Activities

Logistic and administrative tasks, namely reception of members, athletes and visitors of CAR SURF, headquarters of the SCV, support to the monitors in the surf classes, support in the stages and sporting events, European projects, adapted surfing events, exchange programs youth, nautical and sports tourism, university stays. One day a week, the work will be done at APPACDM, a partner entity of the SCV (Institution for the Development of People with Disabilities) supporting the monitors in the curricular activities for the residents. Participate in the SCV volunteer campaign, in particular by supporting the implementation of the Volunteer Management Program, providing information within volunteer project opportunities the association. Develop a plan to implement water and energy savings in CAR SURF. It will develop activities in the scope of its professional formation.

Requirements

Responsibility, creativity, organization, autonomy, ease of interpersonal relations and teamwork, determination, empathy, dynamism, initiative, ability to manage unforeseeable situations; ease of relationship with different groups, nationalities and ages; flexibility to perform different tasks; speak English; interest and motivation for sports and tourism; ease and empathy to work with children and young people; knowledge of key design and communication tools.

Profile He/she must demonstrate interest to learn a new language, be open to experience a new culture, to

contribute to support the Surf Clube de Viana activities. Moreover, the volunteer should feel the

need to prove his/her personal strengths, weaknesses and limits, to discover a new environment,

and a strong desire to make new friends. Showing interest in foreign cultures and having this

experience at this stage in his/her life will help to make decisions for the future, both in terms of

employment and education/training. Must have between 18 and 30 years.

General Conditions

The volunteer will work 33 hours per week and will have 2 free days, most of the activities may be

developed during the weekends, however, it will be compensated with other two consecutive days

during the week, agreed on mutually between the volunteer and the association. The volunteer will

also be entitled to two days off per month, which will be taken according to their own interests and

needs. The SCV provides food allowance, monthly subsidy (pocket money) and accommodation for

the volunteer.

Training

The SCV will ensure that volunteer attend an on-arrival training and later a midterm training. During

the performance of his/her tasks, the volunteer will receive support, guidance and supervision by

the monitor / supervisor who is responsible for each activity. The SCV will ensure that volunteer

have a free language training throughout the whole service. For personal support, the volunteer will

have a mentor, with who they meet weekly throughout the service period. The mentor will assist

with the integration of the volunteer in the association, project and activities. The mentor will also

provide support during the process of learning / Youthpass, reflecting on the former during the

weekly meetings. The mentor will also help in administrative matters, if necessary. SCV will give the

opportunity to the volunteer to meet/ get to know other people and other EVS volunteer and

participate in leisure activities. The SCV will give the volunteer an opportunity to develop a specific

set of tasks, enhancing their creativity while also allowing some of their ideas or experiences to be

integrated. The SCV guarantees, along with the sending entity, that the volunteer receive insurance.

Additional Information

The activities will be carried out at the SCV High Performance Centre. Volunteers will accompany the

SCV team for national events, athlete meetings, seminars, etc., whenever appropriate.
