



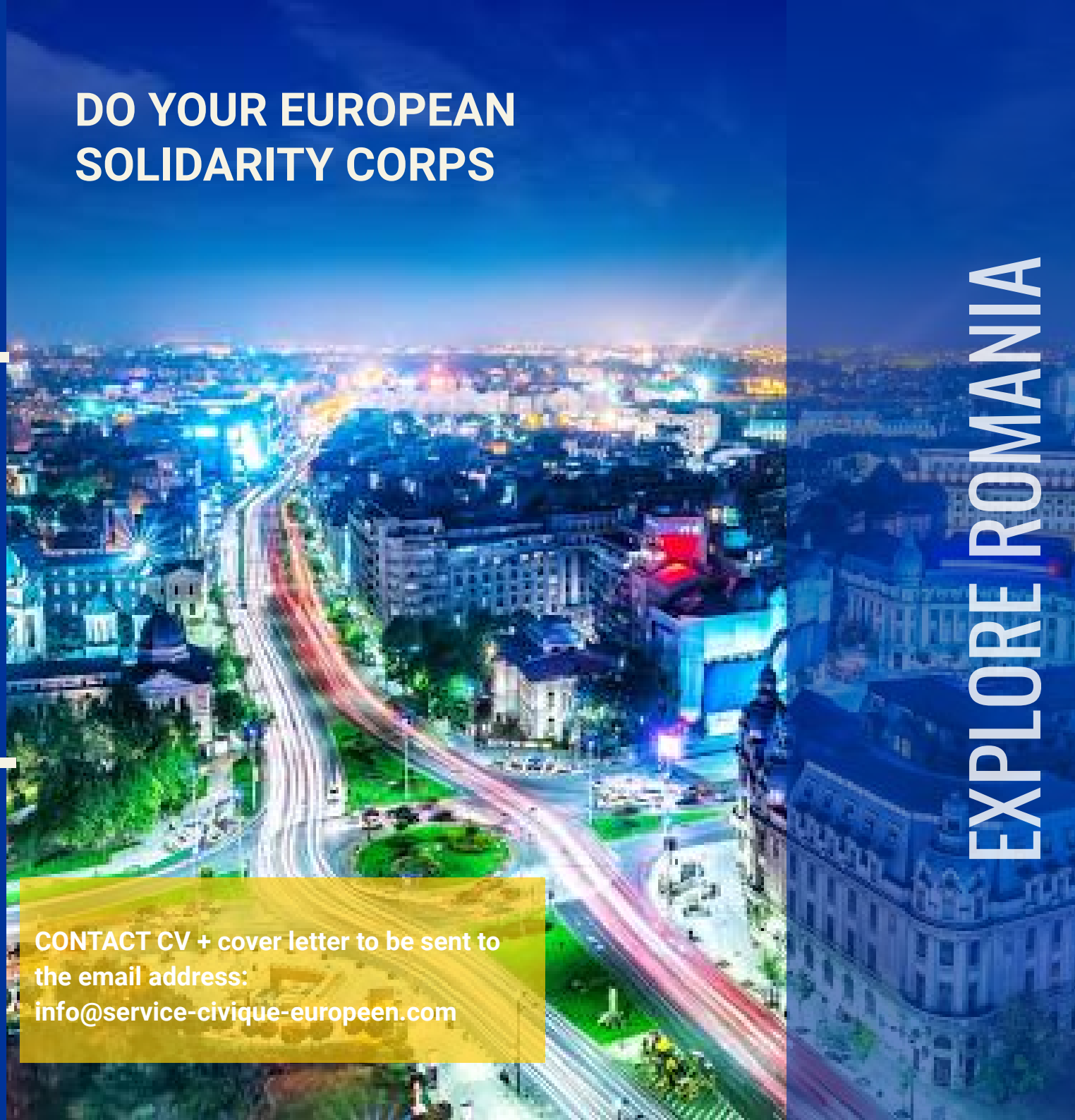

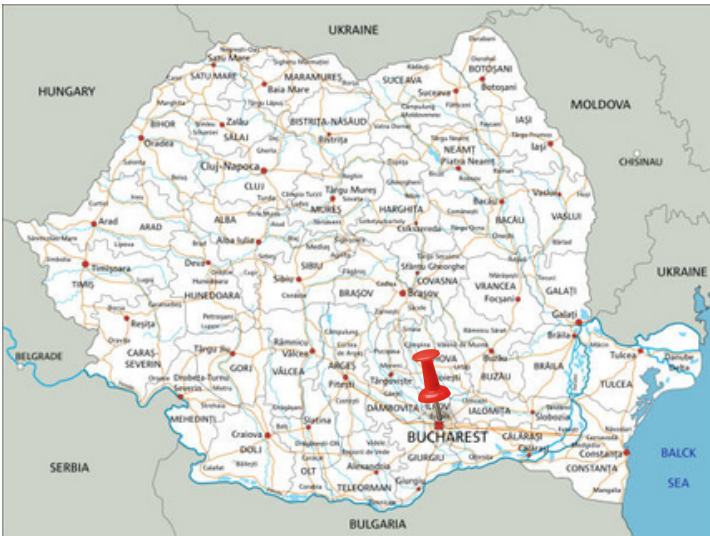

LOCALISATION: BUCHAREST

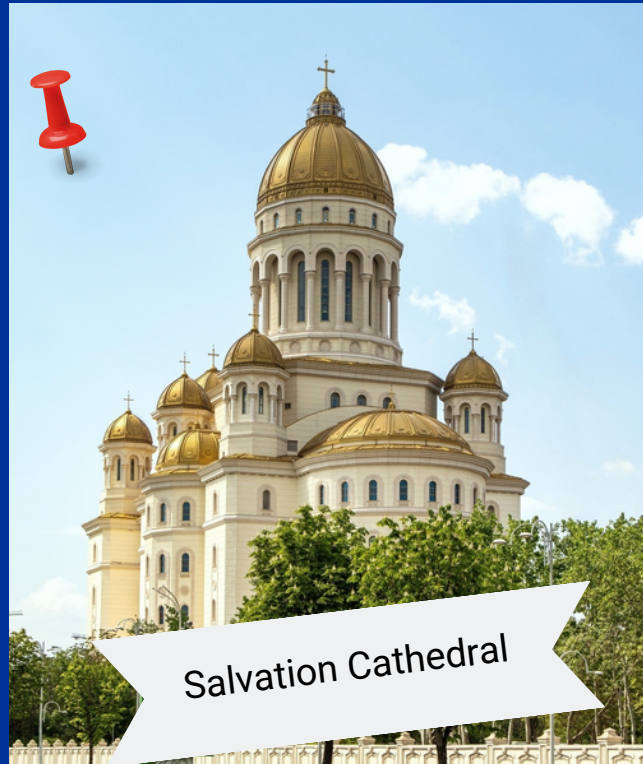

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MISSION

- Develop and implement clinical animation sessions in hospitals and social centers.
- Organize introductory workshops on clinical animation for other volunteers.

Contribute to the creation of visual materials, articles, films and photos for Facebook, the annual magazine, the YouTube channel, Instagram and the blog.

Plan and organize events to promote the European Solidarity Corps (ESC) in general and volunteering in particular, both in person and online.

Provide support in organizing and promoting the organization's annual social and fundraising campaigns. Participate in the creation of artistic events (music, dance, theater) in order to promote supportive behavior among the younger generations.
