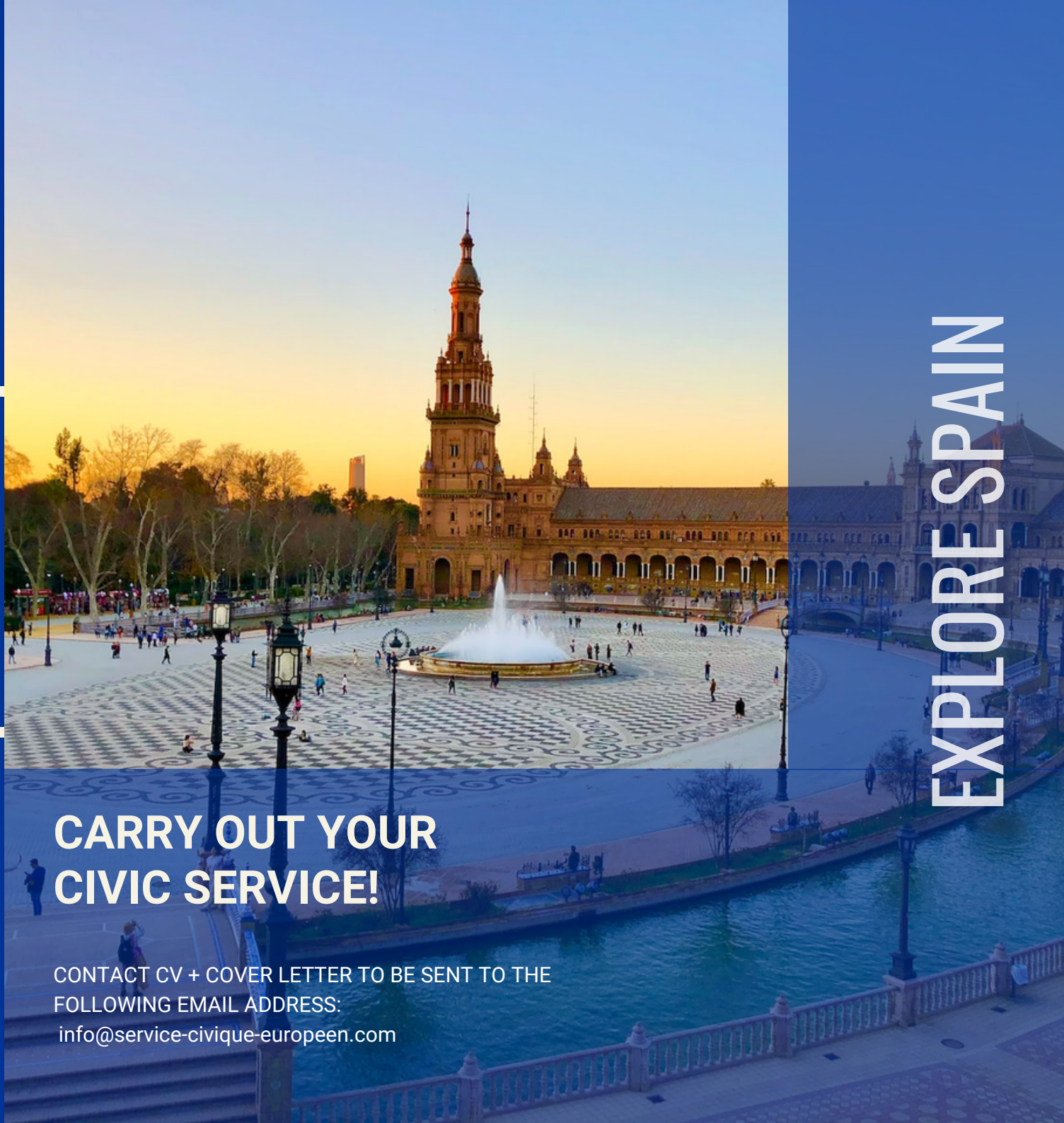

MISSIONS

ACTIVITIES OFFERED TO VOLUNTEERS

The objective of the project is to offer participants the opportunity to learn with the community a series of tools through the following activities:

- management of a vegetable garden to produce food for 50 people;
- welcoming groups (people who come to do seminars, recharge their batteries.)
- collective cooking: learn to compose and prepare balanced menus for groups;
- management of a herd of goats for the production of milk and the processing of dairy products (cheese, yogurt);
- contact with the ecovillage's renewable energies: solar, wind and hydraulic; conscious consumption;
- management of personal and group processes: tools for facilitating and resolving conflicts and tools for developing creativity.
- the volunteer chooses over time an area on which he would like to focus
- each volunteer has a personal mentor and has the opportunity to take a personal development course
