

TEIXINT VINCLES- FAMILY OF VOLUNTEERING

For the sixth consecutive year, the Tallers Foundation is looking for seven volunteers from the European Solidarity Corps aged between 18 and 30 years old, for a long- term volunteer project to take place between January 2023 to February 2024. The European Voluntary Service will act in the Occupational Centre and in the Inclusive Leisure Service supporting and accompanying people with disabilities in those two different services.

The activities that will be developed at the Inclusive Leisure service will be: basketball, yoga, zumba, swimming, gymnastics and stretching, choral singing, going for a drink, weekend activities, weekend trips...

The activities that will be developed at the Occupational Centre Service will be: horticulture, walks with pets, administrative actions in libraries, participation in citizen campaigns, collaboration in campaigns against cancer, connections through painting, collaboration in city campaigns...

The aim is to give people with disabilities the same opportunities, improving inclusion, well-being and self-determination. In addition, volunteers can contribute ideas and proposals activities based in their own talents and interests.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

All volunteers will have the opportunity to develop their own personal projects and will carry out some common activities (already implemented by former volunteers) in Santa Coloma de Gramenet.

Moreover, you will have the chance to be part and help in some of our events, meetings, and projects with local community.

ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

This project is founded by the European Solidarity Corps, and it covers:

-Travel costs (up to the limit established in Erasmus+ Guide distance calculator).

-Accommodation: you will have a single room in a family house in Santa Coloma

de Gramenet, fully equipped (kitchen, bathroom, washing machine, etc...) -Food money

-Pocket money



WHAT TO BRING?

Do not forget to bring with you your own ID card and/or Passport European Health Insurance Card, and Cigna insurance card. You also should provide us your sexual/criminal records.

Be careful: you must keep with you your original travel tickets and your boarding passes; it is needed for the reimbursement.

The rest (clothes, shoes, personal items...) is up to you. The weather is warm but be careful because during winter is almost cold. Check the forecast before packing your stuff.

We also recommend you buy a Spanish SIM CARD as soon as you arrive.
