HOSTING ORGANIZATION

Haus St. Elisabeth is a day care center for disabled adults. The center cares for 20 adults. The emphasis is on individual support and activities tailored to the needs of the residents. The residents are all adults aged between 25 and 80, suffering from various physical and mental disabilities. Activities include individual and group activities, seasonal events, day trips and special occasions. As you will be working with other volunteers, the host organization will propose monthly activities to the team.

HOSTING ORGANIZATION



The YMCA of Esslingen is a Christian organization with its roots in working with children and young people. It organizes activities (cultural, musical, creative, sporting) for young adults, families and the elderly. The office has a team of 15 full-time staff, 18 part-time staff and volunteers. The association runs two youth clubs in the suburbs of Esslingen, where you can help out and volunteer. The Evangelisches Heidehof-Gymnasium is a private school run by the Protestant Church of Baden-Württemberg. It is recognized by the state as a general secondary school and leads to the Abitur. The Evangelisches Heidehof-Gymnasium is home to 650 students, taught by 60 teachers. It is located in a beautiful, midheight setting on the outskirts of Stuttgart.

The school has two profiles, a science profile and a language profile, in which students can learn up to three languages (English, French or Latin and Spanish).

Intercultural learning is a particular strength, with regular exchanges with Spain and France, study trips to Eastern Europe and cooperation with a school in Togo.

In addition, the EHG is a school of democracy, where students experience the foundations of democracy and thus become responsible citizens. It also places great emphasis on the artistic and aesthetic education of its pupils, who take more art and music classes than other schools. Sustainability is a major concern, both in the daily life of the school and through various working groups.



The Georges Cuvier Nursery School is a registered private association. Parents of enrolled children are automatically members of the association. Decisions are taken at a general meeting. Our kindergarten benefits from an attractive environment, with the Parc des Chênes opposite, where you can take short walks with the children and relax during recess. We have 26 employees. Schooling at the nursery school lasts for three years (nursery from 2 years, 3-5 years). Late-night care from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. (activities include movement games, creative crafts and free play) and 20 days of vacation care.

HOSTING ORGANIZATION

The Jugendfarm Esslingen is an interactive outdoor playground based on a farm. Children of all ages can visit the farm, interact with the animals, play and learn in a stimulating environment. The farm is located in a small forest, just a few minutes from Esslingen city center.
