

Family involvement - parents actively participate in educational activities throughout the day. Space for co-decision and mutual responsibility. Good partnerships between family and school team. Selection of future pupils and their parents based on their harmony with the main ideas of the program and working methods. Inclusion of children with special educational needs - conditions for inclusive education. Teacher training, professional seminars, cooperation with specialists.

LOCATION

This project, with variations in the missions, takes place in several French cities, including La Rochelle, Angers, Metz, Caen, and Dunkirk. Each city has its own unique character, combining historical heritage, a vibrant cultural scene, and closeness to nature.

In La Rochelle, volunteers live in a lively port city known for its festivals and cultural exchanges. In Angers, they discover a green, welcoming city renowned for its quality of life.

Wherever you're placed, you'll experience a human-scale environment, ideal for engagement, meaningful encounters, and collaboration.

HOST ORGANIZATION

Unis-Cité is a pioneering association in civic service in France, mobilizing thousands of young people each year in missions of public interest. Since its creation in 1994, it has promoted diversity, social inclusion, and collective engagement.

As part of the European Solidarity Corps, Unis-Cité welcomes European volunteers to collaborate with French volunteers in multicultural teams. The collaboration with the local French volunteers is a very important part of the mission.

Support is personalized, and each volunteer is encouraged to propose ideas and develop their own initiatives.

Volunteering with Unis-Cité is as much a human experience as it is a learning opportunity.


CANDIDATES WE ARE SEEKING

No diploma or level of French is required to participate! This project is open to young people aged 18 to 30 from an ESC participating country.

What we are looking for:

- **Genuine motivation to live a collective and intercultural experience**
- **A desire to connect with elderly people, with kindness and empathy**
- **Willingness to work in a team and get involved in local actions**
- **A spirit of adaptability, tolerance, and creativity**

⚠ Due to time constraints, we are unable to host volunteers who require a visa for this project.



ACCOMMODATION AND PRACTICAL INFO

Volunteers are housed in youth residences located near their mission sites (for example: Horizon Habitat Jeunes in La Rochelle). Accommodation is shared, friendly, and designed for team living.

Each month, volunteers receive approximately €430 (pocket money + food allowance). A public transport pass is provided, and round-trip travel costs from your country are reimbursed according to ESC guidelines.

The program also includes specific training (on animation, elderly support, European citizenship), French language lessons, and individual support (mentor, local coordinator, etc.).



TASKS AND MISSIONS

The project aims to combat the isolation of elderly people through home visits, digital workshops, and group activities. In France, over 1.5 million people over the age of 75 live in social isolation. This volunteering opportunity allows you to respond to this important social issue while experiencing intergenerational solidarity.

You will join one of the following two teams:

Team 1 – Home Visits

- Identify isolated elderly individuals in partnership with local organizations
- Build trust through regular visits conducted in pairs (1 French + 1 European volunteer)
- Propose outings, events, or social activities to strengthen human connection
- Participate in evaluating the impact of your actions

Team 2 – Digital Support and Activities

- Work in elderly care facilities (nursing homes, residences, etc.)
- Lead playful and wellness activities using tablets and gaming consoles (Nintendo Switch, Just Dance, etc.)
- Help raise seniors' awareness of digital tools and communication platforms
- Organize a local senior wellness e-sports competition
- Conduct complementary home visits to build lasting intergenerational bonds

Both teams will also engage in collective activities on European citizenship, cultural awareness, and local partnerships with other associations.
