This projec will takes place in **Murcia**, **Spain**. Specifically in the **FELICIANO SÁNCHEZCEIP Feliciano Sánchez Saura** - Public School.

HOST ORGANIZATION

The **CEIP Feliciano Sánchez Saura** is a public school in **Barrio Peral**, **Cartagena**, serving a diverse student population, including some with language barriers. The school employs an **active**, **participative**, and **hands-on teaching methodology**, emphasizing **emotional well-being** and **values education**.

Its mission is to foster the holistic development of students in a respectful environment that promotes **autonomy, self-determination, responsibility,** and **active learning**. The school's vision is to be a creative, inspiring, and innovative organization that integrates all members of its educational community and interacts with the surrounding environment. The school's core values include **respect**, **empowerment, involvement, creativity, cooperation,** and **sustainability**, all aimed at providing meaningful and experiential learning with a strong focus on the psycho-emotional dimension..

DURATION & SCHEDULE

11 months | From September 2025 to August 2026

The schedule of volunteer activities will be between 30 and 38 hours per week, from 9:00 to 15:00 from Monday to Friday.

CANDIDATES WE ARE SEEKING

This project is aimed at young people between 18 and 30 years old who have not participated in any European volunteering project (EVS or ESC) before. We will give priority to the selection of young people with fewer opportunities.

The selection will be made based on the attitude, the willingness to participate, the motivation and the commitment to the values of the project rather than knowledge and skills of the candidates .

We value the responsibility, the spirit of initiative, the patience and the ability to step back from interpersonal conflicts in order to deal with them more effectively, and the enthusiasm and willingness to participate in the different activities offered.







Volunteer Project Practicalities

This volunteer opportunity offers a comprehensive support package. Volunteers will work 30-38 hours per week, 5 days a week, with 2 days off per month.

Financial & Living Arrangements

- Accommodation: Volunteers will stay in a fully equipped shared flat in Cartagena, with utilities (electricity, water, gas, internet up to €30/volunteer) covered.
- Pocket Money: You'll receive €186 per month.
- Food: An additional €184 per month is provided for food.
- Local Transport: Choose between a bike or bus card.
- Travel Costs: Financial support for travel to and from Spain is provided, based on distance.
- Visa/Permit: Fees for visa and residence permits (if needed) are covered.







Volunteer Project Practicalities

- Language Support: Access to an online language platform is included.
- Medical Insurance: You'll have private insurance covering expenses not met by the public health system.

Deposit

The volunteer will have to make a 370 euro deposit that will be reimbursed once the project is ended and the volunteer leaves tidy, clean, and with no damage in the private room and common areas, and if the volunteer doesn't leave the project without a justified reason before it ends.



- Accompany students pedagogically in the presence of the teacher they are accompanying at the time.

- Activities programmed by the AMPA.
- Entrance and exit of the school: It is very important to be punctual on arrival at school to accompany at the meeting points.
- Remodeling and naturalization of the school space: Painting of walls, installation of furniture.
- School garden: Planting, watering and harvesting tasks.
- Daily reception of families: Accompanying students to leave their things and enter the classroom and to leave the classroom at the end of the daily activity.
- Being in the playground during recess accompanying the children of the school.
- Care of the school space: Helping to maintain order, cleanliness and structure of the spaces.



- Workshops: Organization and collaboration in workshops (cooking, reading, music, theater, crafts, dance, art, etc.).

- Open Day: Collaboration with the school community in the preparation of the Open Day, management of food, music, spaces and activities.

- Excursions with the school community: Games, care for the environment, waste collection, etc.
- Recycling: collaboration in the separation and recycling of waste.

- Art: Development of artistic processes such as drawing, painting, modeling, ceramics, photography, collage, etc., in order to provide the center with a comfortable and welcoming environment.

- Education for Sustainable Development Program: Circular economy activities, care for the environment, collaboration in the creation of a group for the consumption of local and seasonal artisan and/or ecological food, promotion of the use of bicycles and creation of an educational and leisure space in harmony with the natural environment.

LOCATION

This projec will takes place in **Murcia**, **Spain**. Specifically in the **Concejalía de Juventud del Ayuntamiento de Alguazas**.

HOST ORGANIZATION

The **City Council of Alguazas** is a public entity actively engaged with its 1,600 young people (aged 16-30) in a municipality located 15 km from the regional center, with over 10,000 inhabitants.

The City Council fosters close relationships with youth by offering diverse programs that support their interests and encourage their personal and social development. These initiatives include:

- Training, educational, and work activities
- Leisure and free time activities
- Youth exchange experiences
- Promotion of sports, cultural activities, sustainable leisure, and language learning.

Beyond entertainment, these activities are crucial for building social cohesion and enriching the community by promoting shared identity, social interaction, citizen participation, education, awareness, conflict reduction, and local development. They aim to create a dynamic social environment that encourages active participation in society.

- Pocket money: Each volunteer will receive a monthly allowance of 186€, as determined by the Spanish National Agency.
- Food allowance: A monthly food allowance of 184€ will be provided to the volunteer.
- Local transport: Volunteers will have a bus card provided by the hosting organization.







Volunteer Project Practicalities

- Language Support: Access to online language learning resources is provided per ESC program guidelines.
- Medical Insurance: Volunteers are covered by private insurance for health, accident, and civil liability expenses not covered by the public health system.
- Travel Costs: Financial assistance for travel to and from Spain is included, up to an amount determined by the European Commission based on distance.
- Visa & Residence Permit Fees: Support for visa-related expenses is available if needed..

Deposit

Volunteers will be required to provide a 370€ deposit, which will be refunded at the end of the project, provided that the private room and shared areas are left clean and undamaged and that the volunteer completes the project without unjustified early departure.

Volunteers will have a flexible schedule between 30 and 38 hours per week, tailored to both project needs and their interests.

Weekly Activities:

- Monday to Friday (9:00 14:00): Work with the Youth Information Service, directly assisting young people and preparing outreach activities for schools.
- Monday to Friday (15:00 17:30): Provide support at the Ludoteca (playroom) within the Youth Department's Leisure Space.
- Saturdays (9:00 14:00): Facilitate leisure activities in schools.

Additionally, the program includes other seasonal leisure and sports activities for young people.

In addition, our volunteers will participate in the following activities:

- - Promotion of European and mobility projects and programs among the young people of the Region of Murcia, as well as among the users of our organization.

- Accommodation:Volunteers will be provided with a private room in a shared apartment located in Bullas, within a family home. The apartment will be fully furnished, and utilities such as electricity, water, gas, and internet will be covered by the lead organization (up to €30 per volunteer).
- Pocket money: Each volunteer will receive a monthly allowance of 186€, as determined by the Spanish National Agency.
- Food allowance: A monthly food allowance of 184€ will be provided to the volunteer.
- Local transport: Volunteers will have the option to choose between a bicycle or travelling with families from the town of Bullas to the village where the center is located.







Volunteers will be required to provide a 3Volunteers will be required to provide a 370€ deposit, which will be refunded at the end of the project, provided that the private room and shared areas are left clean and undamaged and that the volunteer completes the project without unjustified early departure.



Volunteer Project Practicalities

This volunteer program offers comprehensive support, including online language learning resources, private medical insurance (covering health, accident, and civil liability not covered by public health), financial support for travel to and from Spain (up to an EU-set maximum), and assistance with visa and residence permit fees if required..

- **1. Assisting in Multidisciplinary Workshops.**
- Examples of tasks:
- Helping organize hands-on workshops in areas like art, science, and sustainability.
- Preparing materials for creative projects such as painting murals or crafting with recycled materials.
- 2. Organizing Well-being Activities.
- **Examples of tasks:**
- Leading mindfulness sessions using nature-based practices such as outdoor yoga or quiet reflection by a stream.
- Organizing games that promote teamwork and emotional intelligence, like cooperative obstacle courses or trust-building exercises as well as participating in relational psychomotricity and free movement activities.

- 3. Facilitating Experiential Learning Projects.
- **Examples of tasks:**
- Assisting with project-based learning activities.
- Supporting outdoor expeditions, like treasure hunts or school trips.
- Preparing and organizing all necessary materials for experiential activities, ensuring smooth implementation.

- Accommodation: The volunteers will live in a room in a shared flat located in the city of Murcia together with other volunteers. The room and the flat will be fully equipped, and electricity, water, gas and internet will be covered by the lead organization (till the amount of 30€ per volunteer).
- Pocket money: The volunteer will receive the monthly rate foreseen by the Spanish NA, 186€ per month.
- Food: The volunteer will receive 184€ for food every month.
- Local transport: Every volunteer will have a chance to choose a bike or bus card provided by the hosting organization if it is needed.





Deposit

The volunteer will have to make a 370€ deposit that will be reimbursed once the project is ended and the volunteer leaves tidy, clean, and with no damage in the private room and common areas, and if the volunteer doesn't leave the project without a justified reason before it ends.



Volunteer Project Practicalities

This program provides comprehensive support for volunteers, including online language learning, private medical insurance (covering health, accident, and civil liability), financial assistance for travel to and from Spain (based on EU distance bands), and support for visa and residence permit fees if needed.
